International Coach Clinic at AST 2014

Once again the German Basketball Federation organizes an international coach-clinic in cooperation with FIBA Europe at this year's Albert Schweitzer Tournament. From Thursday (24th April) till Friday (26th April) three top-class coaches will talk about diverse aspects of training methods. Next to the German national coach Frank Menz and Zan Tabak (former coach of Laboral Kuxta), a third highly qualified international coach, whose name will be published soon, will give lectures.

After the check-in on Thursday (11.00 am - 1.00 pm) the first lessons will take place till 4.00pm. Following this the participants will watch three games of the intermediate stage of the AST. The lessons on Friday will take place from 9.00am till 4.15pm. After the lessons, the group will watch the semi-finals at the GBG-Arena. The focus of the last day will be on match analyses. The participants will watch the last four games of the AST, including the big final at 4.15pm.

Frank Menz will give a lecture on tactical details of the "Fast Break" and "Early Offense". The group will have the chance to exchange experiences and discuss the topic. Menz himself played in the Basketball Bundesliga for Neuköllner Sportfreunde and ALBA Berlin. He started his training-career at Wemex Berlin and ended up at the German Basketball Federation in 2006. After coaching several youth national teams he started his job as the men's national coach in 2013.

The former NBA-player Zan Tabak will talk about "Scouting/Recruiting", "Off-ball-defense" and his "Offensive concept". His basketball career, spanning twenty years, was marked by several notable achievements (including the NBA-title in 1995). After his playing career Tabak became a successful club-coach (e.g. assistant coach of Real Madrid, head coach of Laboral Luxta) and will pass on his experiences to the participants.

Jesus "Chus" Mateo will give a lecture von the following aspects of tactics:

- Pick and Roll defense, denying the middle and some offensive solutions.
- Switch as defensive tactical solution.

The 45-year-old has built up a reputation over the past few years. At the Moment Mateo is head coach of the Spanish Club Baloncesto Fuenlabrada. Last year he left the Spanish league for the first time to collect experiences at the Chinese Club Shanxi Zhongyu Brave Dragons. Mateo has coached several Spanish Teams throughout his career, including Unijaca Malaga. He also was assistant coach of Real Madrid and the Spanish national team, with whom he won the European Championship in 2009 and the silver medal at the Olympic Games 2012.
